1. All courses must be taken for a letter grade.
2. Students may petition MMW 2, MMW 5, and DOC 1 for HILD 10-11-12.
3. Lower-division language courses may be transferred, or waived by demonstration through exam.
4. Two years of upper division language is required. If you begin with JAPN 20A-B-C (Second-year Japanese), you will be required to stay for 3 years, or study abroad in Japan after your first year at UCSD.
5. JAPN 190 is required, and 5 upper-division non-language courses from at least two departments.
