If you are interested in joining the Japanese National Honor Society (JNHS), please follow the instructions below.

Step 1.

Note:

Students should be nominated for membership when they are in **the last semester/quarter** before graduating. If you are graduating in the fall quarter, you have to apply during the fall quarter even if you are attending the commencement in June.

Step2.

Send your application to japan@ucsd.edu

Deadline to apply for nomination: Monday of Week 3

a. Fill out the application information below and send it to japan@ucsd.edu **by attachment.**

When you send the application form, put **"JNHS application"** in the subject, and use the file name **"JNHS application_your name"** when you save the application form.

b. Print out the application and sign it.

c. Bring the signed hard copy of the application and a \$20 student application fee (a \$20 check payable to Kyoko Sato; cash is NOT accepted) to the Japanese Studies Office in H&SS Room 1001.

Step 3.

You will be contacted by the Japanese Studies Program office and asked to check the validity of information on your application. Check your UCSD e-mail account at least once every day so that you can reply in a timely fashion.
