Step 1.

Note:

Students should be nominated for membership when they are in the last semester/quarter before graduating. If you are graduating in the fall quarter, you have to apply during the fall quarter even if you are attending the commencement in June.

Step2.

Deadline to apply for nomination: Monday of Week 3

a. Fill out the online application information.

b. Print out the application form on the next page and fill it out completely.

c. Submit the hard copy of your application form and student application fee (a \$20 check payable to Kyoko Sato) to the Japanese Studies Office in H&SS Room 1001 during the student advising hours (MWF 1:00-3:00 and TuTh 9:00-12:00). We only accept checks. Cash is not accepted.

Step 3.

You may be contacted by the Japanese Studies Program advisor to verify the information on your application. Check your UCSD e-mail account at least once every day so that you can reply in a timely fashion.
