Step 1: Application

1. Go to <https://ttbj.cegloc.tsukuba.ac.jp/p1.html>

Note: Use **Google Chrome** to take this test.

2. Click “Test Application” for Individual.

Step 2: User Policy

Read the User policy and check “Agree”, and then click 受験を申し込む (apply for the test).

Step 4: Check the system requirements

(It does not highlight after pressing.)

After you pass the system requirement check, go to the next page.

Step 5: Your Information

Follow the instructions and enter your name and email address in the boxes. After you confirm that you entered your name and email address correctly on the following page, you can apply for the test.

Step 6: Receiving Notification

After you submit the application, you will receive **【TTBJ】受験手続き完了メール** from TTBJ プロジェクトチーム. [ttbj-notify@ttbj.jp]. If you don't receive an e-mail within five minutes, check your junk mail folder or "spam.ucsd.edu".

Step 7: Log-in and Take a Test

Go to <http://ttbj1.cegloc.tsukuba.ac.jp/> and take the test using log-in ID (ログインID) and password (パスワード) given in the e-mail.

Step 8: Receiving Results

After taking the test, you will receive **【TTBJ】受験手完了メール** from TTBJ プロジェクトチーム [ttbj-notify@ttbj.jp] and can check your results. If you don't receive an e-mail, check your junk mail folder.

Step 9: Downloading and Changing the File Name

Download your test results and change the file name.
Please DO NOT FORGET to do this.

If you lack any of these steps, your status on the placement test will be incomplete and will not be reviewed by lecturers.

Once you submit your test scores and score report on Google Form, you are all set.
