# **Language Course Sequence**

#### **IMPORTANT NOTES**

- Not every language course is offered each quarter. Japanese language courses are offered in sequence: A (Fall), B (Winter), and C (Spring), with no summer courses.
- To fulfill a 4-quarter language requirement, you **must** complete JAPN 20A.
- A <u>placement</u> interview is **NOT** the same as a <u>proficiency</u> test.
  - a. Placement Interview = An instructor determines which level course you may enroll in.
  - b. <u>Proficiency Test</u> = An instructor determines your language proficiency. If you have language proficiency equivalent to a 20A level course, it means you must <u>complete</u> 20A to satisfy the four-quarter language requirement.
- \*You must complete your placement interview or proficiency test **BEFORE** enrolling in classes\*
- If you plan to petition Study Abroad courses for your language requirement, please submit all course materials and your petition as soon as your Study Abroad credits have transferred.
